of living or working is and how this can be implemented.

Objectives: This session helps participants:

• recognise the important role that protective factors play in a person's life;

• understanding the impact of someone's stress response because of trauma;

• how trauma and stress can impact people across different aspects of their lives;

• how we build resilience and how that impacts children if they experience resilience from a young age;

• explore why Trauma Informed practice is important in everyday life.
