- Grants of up to £1000 for organisations and micro-grants of up to £100 for individuals are available.
- The fund supports projects and delivery by organisations and individuals that make a difference in the lives of BCH tenants and their local communities.
- Up to 50% of the grant award can be used towards the core running costs of the organisation.

The project must fit into one of the following themes:

- Health and Wellbeing
- Children and Young People
- Cost of Living Support
- Training and Employment Skills
- Connecting Communities
- Environment

- **Applications and Grant Assessments are carried out through the new Bolton CVS website.**
- **11 members of Community Development staff across the seven partner organisations are assessing the applications.**
