Bolton's Fund: Medium Grants

Bolton's Fund Medium Grants are to support medium community groups and charities. In order to be eligible for the Medium Grants Fund, the organisation must have had an income of between £100,0000 and £1 million in the last full financial year.

All projects that receive funding had to demonstrate how their proposed project will address one or more of the Bolton's Fund priorities listed below. The maximum grant size is £15,000.

Batch 3 of the Bolton's Fund: Medium Grants were awarded in Q1.

All applications had to demonstrate how the proposed project addressed at least one of the priorities of Bolton's Fund.

Start Well - giving children the best possible start in life.

Live Well - improving the happiness and wellbeing of Bolton residents.

Age Well - helping older people stay connected, active and healthy in their communities.

Prosperous - supporting enterprise, inclusive employment and maximising social value for Bolton.

Clean and Green - protecting, improving and enjoying our environment.

Safe, strong and distinctive - creating safe, stronger, cohesive and more confident communities.

4 applications were received in Batch 3 totalling £59,996.00.

The grant assessment panel awarded funding to **3 of the projects**.

A total of **£44,996.00 was awarded** in Batch 3 of Bolton's Fund: Medium Grants.
